1. Your information

The information requested is required to process your application for registration of a VIN exempt motor vehicle under part 17 of the Land Transport Act 1998 and to maintain the Motor Vehicle Register. Collection of this information is required by part 1 of the Land Transport (Motor Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Regulations 2011. Corresponding information held on the Driver Licence Register and under the Road User Charges Act 2012 may be amended.

Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, in its capacity as the Registrar of Motor Vehicles (and its agents), will hold, store, use and disclose any personal information collected as part of this application in accordance with the Land Transport Act 1998 and the Privacy Act 1993 (part 11 in particular, which authorises the disclosure of this information in certain circumstances). The Transport Agency (and its agents) may also use this information to communicate with you for the purposes of processing your application, sending you motor vehicle licensing reminders, notifications and information, or obtaining feedback on our services.

To assist in keeping the Electoral Roll up-to-date, the Electoral Enrolment Centre operates an authorised information matching programme with the Transport Agency under s263B of the Electoral Act 1993.

To identify people who have sold more than six motor vehicles in a twelve month period and are not registered as motor vehicle traders, the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment also operates an authorised information matching programme with the Transport Agency under s123 of the Motor Vehicle Sales Act 2003.

Vehicle usage notes:

- For vehicles used in the carriage of goods with a gross vehicle mass (GVM) of 6000kg or greater.
- For vehicles used in the carriage of goods with a GVM of less than 6000kg - for example, courier vehicle, domestic trailer, light goods vehicle.
- Certain vehicles of specified design or use, although required to be registered, qualify for some degree of exemption from other requirements. Factsheet 27 provides a plain English summary and guide to the registration and licensing of exempt vehicles. If you're unsure of your obligations please call us on 0800 108 809.
- Only the following vehicles may be licensed as Exempt Class A:
 - a pedestrian-controlled goods service vehicle
 - an all-terrain vehicle (ATV)
 - a motor vehicle propelled and supported solely by self-laying tracks
 - mobile machinery used only in road construction zones.
- For vehicles designed for the transportation of special purpose equipment, rather than for carriage of goods - for example, trailer type caravans, tractors, graders or self-propelled cranes.
- Agricultural vehicles are vehicles designed, constructed or adapted for agricultural purposes, and include agricultural tractors and agricultural trailers. For a full definition of an agricultural vehicle go to www.nzta.govt.nz/agricultural-vehicles.

4. Model

State the manufacturer's designation (eg Corolla, Commodore) - not the year of manufacture.

5. Vehicle year

Enter the year the vehicle was first registered if it has been registered previously, or enter the year of manufacture if the vehicle has never been registered.

6. Colours

The vehicle colours should be selected from the following: black, blue, brown, cream, gold, green, grey, orange, pink, purple, red, silver, white, yellow.

8. New, scratch-built, used, re-registered

New	A vehicle never previously registered or operated in any country.
Scratch-built	A vehicle never previously registered in any country and is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> assembled from previously unrelated components and construction materials, or a production vehicle where the body and chassis are modified by more than 60%.
Used	A vehicle which has been: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> previously registered overseas and never registered in New Zealand, or operated unregistered either in New Zealand or overseas, including for agricultural operations or off-road use.
Re-registered	A vehicle which has been previously registered in New Zealand and not substantially modified from original condition to be scratch-built.

9. Gross vehicle mass (GVM)

All vehicles except ATVs are required to show the manufacturer's gross vehicle mass in kilograms.

10. Vehicle subject to road user charges

A vehicle subject to road user charges (RUC) is any vehicle that is diesel powered or has a manufacturer's gross vehicle mass (GVM) of more than 3.5 tonnes (3500kg) or is powered by a fuel not taxed at source. State the RUC type. For more information on road user charges, see our website at www.nzta.govt.nz/ruc.

11. Identification details

Individuals - you should present your current New Zealand driver licence. If you can't present your driver licence then you must provide documents which provide proof of your full name, date of birth and signature (eg passport or credit card AND birth certificate). Note: if you use your driver licence as identification then we may update your driver licence address for you as well.

Companies - incorporated organisations may have a Transport Agency customer number which can be used as identification. If you don't have a customer number then you must provide evidence of your NZBN or a certificate of incorporation. You can apply for a customer number using an MR36 form, available at www.nzta.govt.nz/form-MR36. If you're unincorporated, you can provide evidence of your NZBN and your driver licence or proof of your full name, date of birth and signature. For more information go to www.nzta.govt.nz/NZBN.
